Sgt. Amy Dover, Wilmington Police Dept. team leader of the Gang Task Force, will present information on gang presence, gang activities, and how to recognize signs of gang involvement. Gang signs, graffiti, colors, clothing, and many other recognition symbols will be addressed, as well as information on how to report suspicious activities. On May 3, the submarine, USS North Carolina, will be at the State Ports for commissioning. We welcome our new residents into the area, and want everyone to feel wanted and welcome. It appears that landlords and realtors are not advising new tenants or owners of city ordinances regarding garbage, trash, recycling, or parking, so we repeat this information periodically.

Please do not park on or block sidewalks. Motorcycles or mopeds are not allowed on sidewalks. These are city laws, and infractions can result in a ticket and a huge fine.

Garbage day is Friday. This is for garbage cans, recycle bins and yard trash only.

Special pick-up can be arranged for old furniture, carpets, appliances, scrap wood, and other items that are too large for your garbage can. Call 341-7875 to arrange these special pick-ups. Remember that putting trash out other than these times constitutes a city code violation, and can result in fines or discontinuance of services.
