AGENDA HIGHLIGHTS

Ms. Maggie O'Connor, Historic Planner for the City of Wilmington, will present information regarding the pros and cons of Sunset Park becoming a local (City) Historic District. (We are already on the National Historic Register). This information is important to all residents and all property owners within the Greater Sunset Park area, and will help us to decide our future status.

Also, Ms Kaye Graybeal, Director of Planning, will provide information regarding how to attain Historic Status or alternatives if a neighborhood does not qualify for National recognition. Morningside, Woodlawn, Ivey Circle, and our surrounding neighborhoods will find this very informative.

SUNSET PARK ELEM. SCHOOL

The School Board is waiting for final permits for the Sunset Park Elementary School project. Once the permits are obtained, the project will be re-bid. The bids will be presented for approval at the August 4, 2008 Board of Education meeting. The projected cost of the improvements is \$4.4 million. Work is scheduled to start in August 2008, and be completed in September 2009.

Many thanks to the volunteers who helped in the area clean-up on April 19 in the joint venture between SPNA volunteers and Sunset Park Baptist Church volunteers. CONSTRUCTION WORK ON STREETS

Work has begun on the traffic calming street modifications on Northern and Central Blvds. Howard Construction has the \$216,000 contract, and heavy equipment should be moving in starting June 1. Expect some traffic rerouting for the next 90 - 120 days as work progresses. Please keep a vigilant eye for any vandalism and help ensure that our granite curbs are protected and preserved. Thanks.
